## Microphone

If you want to use a hand-held microphone, the rode podcaster is a good one. If you want to use a lapel microphone, the sennheiser or rode lapel mics are top quality but expensive. Any lapel mic will do a reasonable job.

#### Camera

I use a canon, but most of the video cameras these days are good. Look for ones that can connect to a tripod.

You can use an iphone or an ipad to video.

# Connecting an ipad to a tripod

I use a velbon tripod, but you can purchase small table tripods which are adequate.

The Sony ICD-UX is a reliable digital voice recorder.

## Recording apps for phone and ipad

There are more voice recording apps for iPhone and ipad than you could ever hope to try, and most them don't offer much more than the simple functionality you get with Apple's built-in Voice Memo app.

However, if I were to suggest one,

Audio Memos allows you to control your recordings and makes them very easy to share.

For non-apple phones and pads, *Cogi Notes and Voice recorder* does a great job.

## **Editing software – audio**

If you have a mac computer, Garageband is built in.

Audacity is a free program that also works well, and has a PC version.

#### **Editing software – video**

Imovie is built in to apple computers.

Moviemaker is a good basic, easy to use PC program.

Final Cut Pro is for the more adventurous.

You can use powerpoint if you want to!

Wix is a very easy website builder, as is Weebly. I created a website in less than a day with no experience.

#### Cd and dvd makers

There are many firms that will make cds and dvds from your files.

If you want, you can burn your audio to dvd from garageband or audacity.

You can burn a dvd from imovie or moviemaker.

You can add chapters and an introduction through idvd or any of the other dvd authoring programs.

#### **Transcription**

You can get your audio files transcribed by a professional transcriber Or you can send them to transcribers on:

Fiverr, elance, odesk, or peopleperhour (some of these options are better than others, depending on how much time you want to spend editing afterwards.)

# transfer film to computer

A non-professional but do-it-yourself way to transfer film to computer. You will need a very dark, quiet room. Project the film onto a screen and set up a video camera on a tripod above and behind the projector. You can then capture the projected film onto video.
